Funding Structure: Purse of the final shall be the sum
 of \$350,000 and all added fees, less the sum of the
 elimination purses.

1. If more than nine horses declare to start, the event will be raced in heats. The purse for each elimination shall be \$50,000.
 - a) If two (2) eliminations: the first four (4) finishers in each division will qualify for the final. The two (2) official fifth-place finishers will draw by lot for the ninth and final starting position. The other fifth-place finisher shall become the also-eligible.
 - b) If three (3) eliminations: the first three (3) finishers in each division qualify for the final. The three (3) fourth-place finishers will be also-eligibles, with the order to be determined by lot.
 - c) If four (4) eliminations: the top two (2) finishers will qualify for the final. The four (4) third place finishers will draw by lot for the ninth (9th) and final starting position. The remainder of the third place finishers will draw by lot for also eligible positions.
2. Should more than nine (9) horses qualify for the final due to dead heats, horses tied for the final qualifying position(s) will be drawn by lot to complete the field. Under no circumstances shall the field for the final exceed nine starters.
3. An open draw shall determine starting positions for both the eliminations and the final.
4. Purse distribution shall be 50%, 25%, 12%, 8% and 5%.
5. Flamboro Downs Ltd. reserves the right to require six (6) separate wagering interests, or the event may be called off. In such an event, all fees received through nomination, sustaining, starting and supplemental payments shall be divided equally among those declaring to start.
6. Flamboro Downs Ltd. reserves the right to reject any entry by returning fees or to declare the event off if conditions warrant.
7. In the event that Flamboro Downs Ltd. cancels or delays the event due to a labour disruption, inclement weather or some other disruptive force, trainers of nominees shall be notified regarding the rescheduling of the event, such rescheduling to be in accordance with ORC Rule 21.02.
8. The management of Flamboro Downs Ltd. accepts no responsibility for accidents or damage that may occur on the grounds except as a result of negligence.
9. All horses shipped to Flamboro Downs Ltd. require current Coggins Tests.
10. Lasix program is in effect.
11. Rules of the Ontario Racing Commission shall apply.
