Breakage	-Breaks to a dime.	-Breaks to a nickel. The association will continue to use these breaks.
Pool Calculation & Distribution		
Win	-No winners pays a refund.	-No winners pays on the next finisher until a winner is determined. No refund.
Place	-No winners pays only to the other Place finisher, then refund.	-No winners pays on the next finisher until a winner is determined. No refund.
