Summary of the Differences in Rules & Regulations – Kentucky

Rules & Regs	Kentucky	Canada
General Pari-Mutuel Rules		
Breakage	-Breaks to a dime.	-Breaks to a nickel. The association will continue to use these breaks.
Pool Calculation & Distribution		
Win	-No winners pays on the second place finisher, then the third, then refund.	-No winners pays on the next finisher until a winner is determined. No refund.
Place	-No winners pays on the other place finisher, then refund.	-No winners pays on the next finisher until a winner is determined. No refund.
Show	-No winners pays on the other show finishers, then refund.	-No winners pays on the next finisher until a winner is determined. No refund.
Exactor	-No winners pays on 1-ALL and All-2, then refund.	-No winners pays 1-ALL, then refund.
Quinella	-Same as Canada	
Daily Double	-No winners pays on a profit split between the first place finisher in either of the two contests, then a single price pool to the one covered first place finisher in either contest, then as a single price pool to the nearest finisher in each of the two contests. -Scratches in the first leg are treated as refunds and scratches in the second leg after the first leg is off are paid a consolation price.	-No winners pays a single price to the nearest winner in each leg, until a winner is found...No refund -Scratches in the first leg are treated as refunds and scratches in the second leg after the first leg is official are paid a consolation price.
Triactor	-Entries or field horses shall not be allowed in races offering a Triactor.	-Entries or field horses are permitted in races offering a Triactor.
Superfecta	-Same as Canada.	
Pick 3	-If no winners pays 2 of 3, then pays 1 of 3, then refund. -If all Pick 3 legs are cancelled, the pool will be refunded. -If 1 or 2 legs are cancelled, the pool is still valid. -If the racing surface has changed on the 2 nd or 3 rd leg without patron notification prior to the close of wagering, those leg(s) will be treated as 'no contest' for the purpose of calculating the Pick 3 pool.	-If no winners pays 2 of 3, then pays 1 of 3, then pays on 2 nd place finisher then 3 rd and so on. No refund. -If any leg is cancelled before the first leg is made official, the entire pool is refunded. -If the racing surface has changed, it has no affect on the Pick 3.
Pick N (N = 4 or more)	6 methods of distribution are used which include Method 1: the carryover method. Method 2: minor pool and carryover method. Method 3: no minor pool and no carryover method. Method 4: minor pool and no carryover method whereby if the greatest number of 1 st place finishers selected is one, the major and minor shares are combined for distribution as a single-price pool. Method 5: minor pool and no carryover method. Method 6: minor pool, major carryover and jackpot carryover method. -If the racing surface has changed in any leg without patron notification prior to the close of wagering, those leg(s) will be treated as 'no contest' for the purpose of calculating the Pick (n) pool. -The Pick(n) shall be refunded if at least 3 contests cancelled in a Pick 4-6; 4 contests cancelled in a Pick 7-9; 5 contests cancelled in a Pick 10.	-6 methods of distribution are used which include the daily mandatory method, accumulated method, accumulated method with a split, accumulated method with a daily split, daily mandatory method whereby the pool has a major and minor share, and a accumulated method with a daily split whereby the pool has a major and minor share. -If the racing surface has changed it has no affect on the distribution of the pool. -If any leg is cancelled prior to the first leg going Official, pool is refunded. Otherwise pool remains valid.
