Pool Calculation & Distribution		
Win	-No winners pays on the place runner then the show runner, then refund.	-No winners pays on the next finisher until a winner is determined. No refund.
Place	-No winners pays on the other place runner, then refund.	-No winners pays on the next finisher until a winner is determined. No refund.
Show	-No winners pays on the other show runners, then refund.	-No winners pays on the next finisher until a winner is determined. No refund.
Exacta	-No winners pays on a profit split between 1-ALL and ALL-2, then refund.	-No winners pays 1-ALL, then refund.

Daily Double	-No winners pays on a profit split between 1-ALL and ALL-1, then 2-ALL and ALL-2, then refund. -If the racing surface has changed and notification to patrons was not given prior to the pool closing, the leg will be treated as being cancelled with respect to the Daily Double pool. -Scratches in the first leg are treated as refunds and scratches in the second leg after the first leg is <u>official</u> are paid a consolation price.	-No winners pays a single price to the nearest winner in each leg, until a winner is found...No refund -If the racing surface has changed, it has no effect on the Daily Double. -Scratches in the first leg are treated as refunds and scratches in the second leg after the first leg is <u>official</u> are paid a consolation price.
Trifecta	-No winners pays 1-2-ALL, then 1-ALL-3, then 1-ALL-ALL, then ALL-2-3, then refund.	-No winners pays 1-2-ALL, then 1-ALL-ALL, then refund.

Pick 3	-Scratches in any leg prior to the start of the first leg are treated as refunds and scratches in the second and third leg after the first leg is off are treated as consolation prices, similar to the Daily Double. -If the racing surface has changed and notification to patrons was not given prior to the pool closing, the leg will be cancelled with respect to the Pick 3 pool. -Deadheats are paid based on a profit split similar to the way the place pool is calculated. -If 1 or 2 of the legs are cancelled, all runners in those legs will be flagged as winners.	-Scratches in the Pick 3 pool are substituted with the Win pool favorite. -If the racing surface has changed, it has no effect on the Pick 3. -Deadheats share in the winning money used to calculate the single price payout. -If first leg is cancelled, the entire pool is refunded.
Pick N (N = 4 or more)	-2 methods of distribution are used which include the Pick(N) with carryover and Pick(N) with minor pool and carryover. -If the racing surface has changed and notification to patrons was not given prior to the pool closing, the leg will be cancelled with respect to the Pick(N) pool. -If at least one leg is cancelled in the Pick(N), the carryover from previous performances will not be paid out and the net pool will be paid out to the greatest number of correct legs. -The Pick(N) pool shall be refunded if 3 or more races are cancelled on a Pick 4 or 5, 4 or more races are cancelled on a Pick 6 or 7, or 5 or more races are cancelled on a Pick 8 or 9, or 6 or more races are cancelled on a Pick 10 or 11.	-6 methods of distribution are used which include the daily mandatory method, accumulated method, accumulated method with a split, accumulated method with a daily split, daily mandatory method whereby the pool has a major and minor share, and an accumulated method with a daily split whereby the pool has a major and minor share. -If the racing surface has changed it has no effect on the distribution of the pool. -Carryover is not paid out if more than 1/2 of the legs are cancelled. -Pool is only refunded if the first leg of the pool is cancelled. All other cancelled legs will be paid out to the greatest number of correct legs.
Super 6	-100% of net pool is distributed for correctly selecting the winner in each leg. If there are no winning tickets selecting every leg, 25% of the net pool will be paid out to the ticket holders selecting the greatest number of winning legs and the remaining 75% of the pool will be carried forward. -Pool shall be refunded if 3 or more races are cancelled.	-Same as Pick(N)
