

## Summary of the Differences in Rules & Regulations

Rules & Regs	New York	Canada
<b>General Pari-Mutuel Rules</b>		
Breakage	\$2.10 to 9.99 payoff, break to 10 cents; \$10 to 49.99 payoff, break to 20 cents; \$50 to 499.99 payoff, break to 50 cents; \$500 and up, break to \$1.00.	-Breaks to a nickel. The association will continue to use these breaks.
Scratching of Entries	-When part of an entry is scratched after odds/probables have been displayed; the remaining parts of the entry run for purse money only.	-When part of an entry is scratched the other remaining parts remain as a betting interest.
<b>Pool Calculation &amp; Distribution</b>		
Win	-No winners refund the pool.	-No winners pays on the next finisher until a winner is determined. No refund.
Place	-No winners pays on the other place runner, then refund.	-No winners pays on the next finisher until a winner is determined. No refund.
Show	-No winners pays on the other show runners, then refund.	-No winners pays on the next finisher until a winner is determined. No refund.
Exactor	-Pool is refunded if betting interests less than 4.	-Pool is refunded if betting interests less than 2.
Quinella	-Same as Canada	
Daily Double	-No winners in the first leg, the pool is refunded. No winners in the second leg, the pool pays 1-ALL. -If the first leg cancels, the whole pool is refunded. -Scratches in the first leg are treated as refunds and scratches in the second leg after the first leg has raced are paid a consolation price.	-No winners pays a single price to the nearest winner in each leg, until a winner is found. No refund -If either leg cancels prior to the first leg, the whole pool is refunded. -Scratches in the first leg are treated as refunds and scratches in the second leg after the first leg is official are paid a consolation price.
Triactor	-Pool is refunded if betting interests less than 6.	-Pool is refunded if betting interests less than 3.
Superfecta	-Pool is refunded if betting interests less than 7.	-Pool is refunded if betting interests less than 4.
Pick 3	-No winners pays 2 of 3, then pays 1 of 3, then refund. -Scratches prior to the start of the first leg are treated as refunds and scratches after the first leg has started are paid a consolation price. -Deadheats are paid based on a profit split similar to the way the place pool is calculated.	-No winners pays 2 of 3, then pays 1 of 3, then pays on 2 <sup>nd</sup> place finisher then 3 <sup>rd</sup> and so on. No refund. -Scratches in the Pick 3 pool are substituted with the Win pool favorite. -Deadheats share in the winning money used to calculate the single price payout.
Pick 4	-Pool is only distributed using the daily mandatory method. -If no winners pays 3 of 4, then pays 2 of 4, then pays 1 of 4 then refund.	-6 methods of distribution are used which include the daily mandatory method, accumulated method, accumulated method with a split, accumulated method with a daily split, daily mandatory method whereby the pool has a major and minor share, and an accumulated method with a daily split whereby the pool has a major and minor share.

		<p>-If no winners pays 3 of 4, then pays 2 of 4, then pays 1 of 4. If still no winners pool pays on 2<sup>nd</sup> place finisher then 3<sup>rd</sup> and so on. No refund.</p>
<p>Pick 6</p>	<p>-Pool is distributed by the accumulated method with a daily split, whereby the pool has a major and minor share.          -Previous day's carryover will not be paid out if 1 or more legs are cancelled.          -Pool is only refunded if all legs of the pool are cancelled.          -If a race is taken off of the turf and put onto the dirt, the PK6 will pay an 'All' for that leg. If more than one race pays an 'All' because of this, the previous day's carryover won't be paid out.</p>	<p>-6 methods of distribution are used which include the daily mandatory method, accumulated method, accumulated method with a split, accumulated method with a daily split, daily mandatory method whereby the pool has a major and minor share, and an accumulated method with a daily split whereby the pool has a major and minor share.          -Previous day's carryover will not be paid out if more than 50% of legs are cancelled during distribution method 2-4.          -Pool is refunded if any leg is cancelled prior to the first leg going official.          -If a race is taken off the turf and put onto the dirt, the Pick(n) is unaffected.</p>
