

Summary of the Differences in Rules & Regulations – West Virginia

Rules & Regs	West Virginia	Canada
General Pari-Mutuel Rules		
Breakage	-Breaks to a dime.	-Breaks to a nickel. The association will continue to use these breaks.
Minimum Payoff	-Dime on every dollar	-Nickel on every dollar. The association will continue to use this minimum.
Pool Calculation & Distribution		
Win	-No winners pays on the second place finisher, then the third, then refund.	-No winners pays on the next finisher until a winner is determined. No refund.
Place	-No winners pays on the other place finisher, then the third place finisher, then refund.	-No winners pays on the next finisher until a winner is determined. No refund.
Show	-No winners pays on the other show finishers, then the fourth place finisher, then refund.	-No winners pays on the next finisher until a winner is determined. No refund.
Exactor	-No winners pays 1-All, All-2 then refund.	-No winners pays 1-ALL, then refund.
Quinella	-Same as Canada.	
Daily Double	-Scratches occurring in the 2 nd leg after the close of the 1 st leg receive a consolation payout. -No winners pays 1-All All-1, then 2-2, then refund.	-Scratches in the first leg are treated as refunds and scratches in the second leg after the first leg is official are paid a consolation price. -No winners pays a single price to the nearest winner in each leg, until a winner is found...No refund
Triactor	-No winners pays, 1-2-All then 1-All-All, then All-2-All, then All-All-3, then refund.	-No winners pays 1-2-ALL, then 1-ALL-ALL, then refund.
Superfecta	-No winners pays, 1-2-3-All, then 1-2-All-All, then 1-All-All-All, then All-2-3-4, then All-All-3-4, then All-2-All-All, then All-All-3-All, then All-All-All-4, then refund.	-No winners pays 1-2-3-ALL, then 1-2-ALL-ALL, then 1-ALL-ALL-ALL then refund.
Pick 3	-If no winners pays 2 of 3, then 1 of 3, then refund.	-If no winners pays 2 of 3, then pays 1 of 3, then pays on 2 nd place finisher then 3 rd and so on. No refund.
Pick N (N = 4 or more)	-5 methods of distribution which include: Method 1-Pick(n) with carryover, Method 2-Pick(n) with minor & carryover, Method 3-Pick(n) with no minor & no carryover, Method 4-Pick(n) with minor & no carryover whereby if there are no wagers selecting the 1 st place finisher in a second greatest number of pick(n) contests, the minor share of the net pick(n) pool shall be combined with the major share for distribution as a single-price pool to those who selected the 1 st place finisher in the greatest number of pick(n) contests. If the greatest number of 1 st place finishers selected is one, the major and minor shares are combined for distribution as a single-price pool. Method 5-Pick(n) with minor & no carryover whereby if there are no wagers selecting the 1 st place finisher in all pick(n) contests, the entire net pick(n) pool shall be distributed as a single-price pool to those who selected the 1 st place finisher in the greatest number of pick(n) contests. If there are no wagers selecting the first-place finisher in a 2 nd greatest number of pick(n) contest, the minor share of the net pick (n) pool shall be combined with the major share for distribution as a single-price pool to those who selected the 1 st place finisher in each of the pick(n) contests.	-Prices are calculated using NPP. -6 methods of distribution are used which include the daily mandatory method, accumulated method, accumulated method with a split, accumulated method with a daily split, daily mandatory method whereby the pool has a major and minor share, and a accumulated method with a daily split whereby the pool has a major and minor share.
