

## Summary of the Differences in Rules & Regulations – Arizona

Rules & Regs	Arizona	Canada
<b>General Pari-Mutuel Rules</b>		
Breakage	-Breaks to a dime.	-Breaks to a nickel. The association will continue to use these breaks.
<b>Pool Calculation &amp; Distribution</b>		
Win	-No winners pays on the second place finisher, then the third, then refund.	-No winners pays on the next finisher until a winner is determined. No refund.
Place	-No winners pays on the other place finisher, then the third, then refund.	-No winners pays on the next finisher until a winner is determined. No refund.
Show	-No winners pays on the other show finishers, then the fourth, then refund.	-No winners pays on the next finisher until a winner is determined. No refund.
Exactor	-No winners pays a profit split between 1-All & All-2, then single price to 1-All or All-2, then refund.	-No winners pays 1-ALL, then refund.
Quinella	-Same	
Daily Double	-No winners pays profit split of 1-All & All-1, then single price to 2-2, then refund. -Scratches in the first leg are treated as refunds and scratches in the second leg after the first leg is <u>off</u> are paid a consolation price.	-No winners pays a single price to the nearest winner in each leg, until a winner is found...No refund -Scratches in the first leg are treated as refunds and scratches in the second leg after the first leg is <u>official</u> are paid a consolation price.
Triactor	-Same	
Superfecta	-Same	
Pick 3	-No winners pays 2 of 3, then 1 of 3, then refund. -If 2 legs are cancelled then refund.	-If no winners pays 2 of 3, then pays 1 of 3, then pays on 2 <sup>nd</sup> place finisher then 3 <sup>rd</sup> and so on. No refund. -If any leg is cancelled before the first leg is made official, the entire pool is refunded.
Pick N (N = 4 or more)	-5 methods: Pick(N) w/Carryover, Pick(N) w/ Minor Pool & Carryover, Pick(N) No Minor & No Carryover, Pick(N) w/Minor Pool and No Carryover & Pick(N) w/Minor Pool & No Carryover. -If 3 Pick (4,5,& 6) legs are cancelled then refund, 4 Pick (7,8 & 9) legs are cancelled then refund, 5 Pick 10 legs are cancelled then refund. -If at least 1 leg is cancelled, 100% of net pool will be paid out, not including previous day's carryover.	-6 methods of distribution are used which include the daily mandatory method, accumulated method, accumulated method with a split, accumulated method with a daily split, daily mandatory method whereby the pool has a major and minor share, and a accumulated method with a daily split whereby the pool has a major and minor share. -If any leg is cancelled prior to the first leg going Official, pool is refunded. -Previous day's carryover will not be paid out if more than 50% of legs are cancelled during distribution method 2-4. 100% of net pool will be paid out, not including previous day's carryover to the greatest number of winners if at least one leg is cancelled for distribution method 6.
